The Northwest Ohio Regional Information System (NORIS) Core Service Bureau is a subscription service that provides mobile access to data critical for law enforcement function. The NORIS Core Service Bureau is hosted by NORIS.

Provided Services

LEADS Databases	Provides access to state and federal vehicles, state/federal warrants and criminal histories.
NORIS Databases	Provides access to NORIS data, including local warrants, criminal histories and corrections.
LocatePLUS Investigative Database	Contains information on people, addresses, property, vehicles, court actions and phone numbers.
24x7 Technical Support	All Core Service Bureau subscriptions include 24x7 technical support.

Requirements

ORI	If you do not have an ORI and are a valid law enforcement agency, NORIS can assist you in obtaining an ORI. Please contact Mike Antel (mike.antel@NORIS.org) if you have any questions.
Each end user must be LEADS operator certified	To verify operator certification, the following information will be asked: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name• Date of Birth• Social Security Number• Ohio Operator's License Number If your operators need certification, NORIS can assist with that process. BlackBerry Device	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• BlackBerry device with v4.0 or higher of the operating system.• Data coverage from a qualified provider (Nextel, Cingular or AT&T).• Anti-virus software installed on the BlackBerry device.

Licensing

Ohio NORIS LEADS Access	The subscription to the NORIS and LEADS systems uses concurrent licensing. You only need to purchase licenses for the amount of officers who need to use the service at the same time. For example, if your agency has 50 officers but only 15 are on duty per shift, you will only need 15 licenses.
LocatePLUS	The LocatePLUS subscription is licensed per user. Each user who needs to access LocatePLUS will require a separate license. For example, if 5 detectives need access, you will need 5 LocatePLUS licenses.

The Northwest Ohio Regional Information System (NORIS) was founded in 1976 to provide records automation for Toledo Municipal Court, the Toledo Police Department, and the Lucas County Sheriff's Office. By 1988, NORIS was supporting 88 terminals in city and county offices. Currently, NORIS supports over 1,000 terminals in seven counties that link more than 2,600 users who collectively perform more than seven million transactions per month. NORIS maintains criminal histories on 680,000 offenders and offers on-line access to active local warrants. State and federal law enforcement databases are accessed through NORIS seven million times per year.
